

Based on Article 28 of the Statute of the European Faculty of Law (clean copy from 8 August 2016), on 26 September the Management Board of the Faculty (hereinafter: MB-EFL) adopted the following

## **Rules on Preparation for International Study Exchange at MCL Jackson**

### Article 1 (Content)

These rules regulate rights and responsibilities of students participating in the superior educational program in order to prepare for international study exchange at Mississippi College School of Law, Jackson, USA (hereinafter: MCL Jackson) and the European Faculty of Law (hereinafter: EFL).

### Article 2 (Content, conditions and duration of exchange)

The content of international study exchange, its conditions and duration are determined in the agreement between MCL Jackson and EFL which is part of these Rules.

### Article 3 (study exchange)

Student enrolled in and having completed the superior educational program may be sent to international study exchange at MCL Jackson making it possible to obtain the additional American degree.

### Article 4 (candidates for exchange)

The superior educational program is accessible to 3rd year students of first cycle study programs and to all students of second and third cycle study programs.

### Article 5 (superior educational program)

The superior educational program amounts to 12 ECTS and comprises 3 courses:

- Advanced English Legal Terminology (4 ECTS);
- Introduction to US and Comparative Law (4 ECTS);
- Legal Writing and Methodology (4 ECTS).

### Article 6 (tuition fee for the superior educational program)

The tuition fee for the superior educational program is EUR 750.00 and may be settled in 3 consecutive instalments.

#### Article 7 (recognition of superior educational program)

According to Rules and Regulations on the Study at EFL, credits acquired within ECTS may be recognized as informal additional education. A degree is issued upon successful completion of stated courses.

#### Article 8 (provision of superior educational program)

The superior educational program lasts 1 semester. It starts in November and ends in March by passing a longer written exam within the course Legal Writing and Methodology.

#### Article 9 (selection)

In April, a selection is made among students who have successfully completed the superior educational program and who may enter the international student exchange based exclusively on meritocratic criteria. These are:

- Overall grade at the Faculty (average grade);
- average grade of two courses from the superior educational program (40%) and the written exam (60%);
- CV, with the emphasis on previous extra curricular activities;
- level of knowledge of English language.

#### Article 10 (entry into force of these Rules)

These Rules were adopted by the MB-EFL and enter into force upon their publication.
